- Reviewing easy read information for the Greater Preston and Chorley and South Ribble CCG's



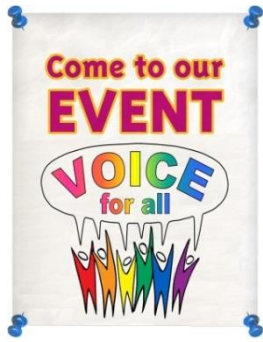
- Giving a presentation at the Lancashire Learning Disability Partnership Board
